

Job Title: Yellow Farmhouse Summer Intern

Description:

The Yellow Farmhouse summer internship program is designed for rising high school seniors with an interest in food and agriculture. Interns work alongside educators, farmers, chefs, and food entrepreneurs to explore a variety of career paths in the local food movement. By working on a sustainable vegetable farm, teaching youth programs, and educating consumers about local foods, interns develop skills to move confidently towards a career aligned with their interests. In addition to gaining hands-on work experience, interns participate in a staff development program designed to expand their knowledge of sustainable agriculture and food justice.

Responsibilities

- Help maintain our micro farm and vegetable garden by weeding, pruning, harvesting, etc.
- Assist Yellow Farmhouse staff with summer children's programs
- Support Yellow Farmhouse staff with adult classes and teacher workshops
- Support our Preserving the Bounty program by gleaning produce and coordinating donations
- Participate in the Dandelion Speaker Series

Requirements

- Ability to work in various weather conditions
- Ability to lift at least 50 lbs (produce crates, tools, etc)
- Good communication skills
- Comfortable working with children ages 6-11

Compensation

Interns will earn \$14/hr and work up to 30 hours per week for a period of 8 weeks between June and August 2022. Additional funding is available to help defray transportation costs, if needed.
